Classroom Expectations

Be Respectful

- Respect yourself, your classmates, and the Fraser staff at ALL times

Be Responsible

- Take responsibility for all your actions.

Be Ready

- come to class on time with all necessary materials (including completed homework)

Supplies

- ◆ 1" Binder for Algebra use Only with dividers (warm ups, notes, homework, quizzes)
- ◆ Pencils and Red Pens
- ◆ TI-84 Graphing Calculator (recommended; classroom calculator is usually available)

Absences

If you happen to be absent, it is your responsibility to check find out what was missed from Ms. Jager's website. For every day you are absent, you will have ONE day to make up your missing assignments. If the missing work is not turned in within this time frame you will receive a zero. If a quiz or a test was scheduled the day you were absent, you are still required to take the quiz or test on the day you return. If you miss a quiz or test, you have 2 seminar days to make it up!!!!

Tardies

If you stroll in late, you are telling me my class is not important. Class begins immediately when the bell rings. If you are tardy to class, you will find the door is closed and locked when you arrive. You must wait outside until attendance has been taken. You must have a written pass for an excused tardy. Two tardies will equal one absence.

Homework

Homework will be assigned and collected a daily basis and worth 20% of your grade. You are expected to complete every problem assigned and show ALL work. Assignments will be graded on completeness and correctness.

Late Work

Homework is assigned at the time that is assigned for a reason. It will be very difficult if not impossible to keep up with this class if you do not complete homework on time. Any late work will be accepted with a maximum of 50% credit and will not be accepted after a test is taken on the material. This goes for any homework that was not done, left at home, left in your locker, left in the car, eaten by a pet shark, etc. If it is not here on the day it is due, then it is late.

Re-Tests

You will be allowed to retake tests if: 1.) You have 100% of the units homework completed and 2.) You come to seminar or after school for extra help before the re-test.

Seminar

Seminar is a great opportunity to catch up on missing work or receive extra help. I am more than willing to provide any extra help needed, but it is your responsibility to come see me during seminar. I don't know if you need help if you don't ask. Make sure your agenda is signed before seminar begins.
